

Truck: delivery vehicle that is used to distribute mail.

Stamp: any stamp, postage impression or postage meter impression authorized by Canada Post for the purpose of paying postage.

Mail: letters and packages processed by the postal system.

Box: a container with a flat base and sides, typically square or rectangular and having a lid.

Office: place of work.

Envelope: a flat paper container with a sealable flap, used to enclose a letter or document.

Address: the destination where mail is delivered to and received at.

Order: a request to be made and supplied.

Package: any wrapped bundle which exceeds the dimension or weight of a Standard or Oversize letter.

Delivery: action of delivering letters and packages.

Transport: take or carry goods from one place to another by means of a vehicle, aircraft or ship.

Duty: money requested by the jurisdiction of a country for fiscal purpose.
